WERE YOU AWARE THAT.....

Sea cargo transportation takes 99% of the world cargo market which leaves about 1% only (by weight) for the air transportation industry. The recent boom in the global economy has driven the sea freight market high and order books of most of world's shipyards are full through the next 5 years.

There are about 40,000 ships plying across oceans, and approximately 6 new vessels are expected to be delivered every day for the next 3 years. Each ship requires a Captain and three navigating officers. Currently, there is a huge shortage of officers globally with situation expected to worsen.

Our course leads the students through a structured training program preparing them for their first professional certification at sea – Class 3 (Deck) Unlimited Certificate of Competency.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

At the end of this course, participants are able to safely, efficiently and competently carry out the watch keeping duties on board merchant ships both at sea and in port. They will be conversant with the basic principles as per STCW Regulations VIII/2 & STCW Code Chapter VIII.

COURSE CONTENT:

The course is conducted over 3 stages, as follows:

STAGE 1: Pre Sea Program (PSP)

3-months duration, conducted on board our training ship or at our shore based institute.

This course is accredited by Maritime NZ and conducted by Institute of Maritime Education & Training Pty Ltd, Australia.

The certification acquired is a world class certificate and in compliance with the requirements of the International Maritime Organisation as well as the relevant sections of the Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping (STCW) for Seafarers, 1978, as amended.

Stage 3 – Certificate of Competency Class 3 (Deck) Unlimited

A 5-month preparatory program leading to the trainees obtaining their Class 3 (Deck) Unlimited CoC issued by the Maritime New Zealand provided all the assessment and other criteria are fully met with, by the student.

Entry Requirements:

- 10+2 or GCSE 'A' Level or equivalent with passes in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics
- Students with commerce background at 10+2 level can be considered on a case-by-case basis
- Eyesight as per IMO/NZ Standards & Requirements
- Age 16 to 25 years
