


NZ DECK & ENGINEER WATCHKEEPER COURSES





Course Name: Certificate of Competency Class 3 (Unlimited)

Course Delivery and Location:

<u>PHASE I</u>: Conducted by IMETA at our campuses across Asia (including on board our training ship), this 3-month pre sea training acts as a foundation course enabling students to serve on board merchant ships as deck cadets

<u>PHASE II</u>: Students will serve 18 months on board merchant ships as deck cadets, acquiring practical knowledge and skills enabling them to become officers upon completion of this course. They will also enhance their knowledge by continuing to learn through a MNZ approved distance-learning programme

<u>PHASE III</u>: Conducted by New Zealand Maritime School at their campuses in Auckland, NZ. This 6-month study programme at NZMS provides students with the knowledge and skills necessary to obtain the Certificate of Competency (Deck) from MNZ. It covers all requirements of the STCW 95 Convention, as amended, for this level including all necessary mandatory short courses.

Requirements and pre-requisites

Course Entry Qualification:

- GCSE "A" Level or equivalent (10+2) with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics
- Medical and Eye Sight standards as per MNZ/IMO requirements

Certificate of Competency (CoC) Deck Watchkeeper:

 Students must take an MNZ Oral Examination as well as complete all ancillary courses required for the CoC to be issued, for which a sea-time assessment must be undertaken with MNZ, as per their requirements



Served as deck cadet or rating on board merchant ships?

We organise courses for candidates who have the served on board merchant ships as deck cadets or ratings without a formal or MNZ approved pre-sea training

Eligibility Criteria:

- At least 20 years of age
- Must have completed at least 36 months of qualifying sea service. Those with more than 24 months sea time may apply for their eligibility assessment and reduction of sea time may be granted on a case by case basis.
- At least 12 months of the above must have been served on ships with voyages of 24 hours or more
- Served at least 6 months understudy of the officer in charge of a navigational watch on a trading ship

Eligibility Criteria:

- · At least 19 years of age, of good character and medically fit to MNZ standards
- At least 42 months on vessels powered by engines of more than 750kW operating beyond restricted limits
- At least 6 of these must have been on engine room watch keeping duties.
